As an electric cooperative committed to supporting our community, we provide this annual scholarship program to children of members of Holmes-Wayne Electric Cooperative, Inc. (HVEC)

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

To be eligible for the Holmes-Wayne Electric Scholarship Awards, the following provisions will govern the acceptance of applications:

1. Applicants must be sons, daughters, or legal wards of Holmes-Wayne Electric Cooperative, Inc., residential members, living on the lines and receiving service at the time of competition.
2. Applicants cannot be immediate family members of or reside with individuals employed by HVEC.
3. Applicants must be ***graduating high school seniors*** with all basic credits for college, or proper vocational, or technical school entrance. (Proper vocational or technical schools are defined as postsecondary institutions where credits can be transferred to state-accredited four-year colleges.)
4. Applicants must have a current career average of 3.6 or above on a 4.0 scale, or equivalent standing on a nontraditional scale.
5. Applications for the local Holmes-Wayne Electric Cooperative, Inc. competition must be submitted (typed) on the forms provided by HVEC. Application forms must be returned to the co-op office by Friday, January 23, 2026. Application information must be confined to the official form. The only attachments permitted are: transcript, teacher recommendations, essay response, and one photo of the applicant. (Teacher recommendations shall not exceed 500-words.)
6. Essay response should be done in your own words and should follow acceptable APA writing standards.
7. Applicants who have received “full ride” scholarships (tuition, room, board, and books) to the schools of their choice are not eligible.
8. Qualified applicants will be contacted for an interview in late February. If you have any questions regarding the scholarship competition, please feel free to contact HVEC at 866-674-1055. Applications (3 page) with transcript, teacher reference and student photo must be submitted or post marked by Friday, January 23, 2026.
9. Upon completion of the scholarship process, winning applicant will be eligible to attend an additional scholarship interview to win an additional scholarship.
